Frequently Asked Questions

1. **What is the age cut-off for registration?** Students must be 5 years of age **ON OR BEFORE September 1st, 2017**. Students turning 5 between **September 2nd and December 2nd, 2017** are eligible to register for a two-year Transitional Kindergarten program.
2. **What do I need to register my student?** Original birth certificate, immunization records, social security card, proof of residence (PG & E bill, water bill, recent pay check stub with address, recent property tax payment, escrow papers) birth parent/legal guardian's driver license.
3. **Who can register my student?** Birth parents or legal guardians **ONLY**. Unfortunately, step-parents, grandparents, siblings, etc. are **UNABLE** to register students.
4. **Do you take requests for AM/PM Kindergarten?** You may request AM or PM Kindergarten at the time of registration but no preference request is guaranteed.
5. **Can I get the registration packet in advance?** We do not hand out packets ahead of time, however; if you bring copies of all the required items listed above, the process will go quickly. It usually takes between 15-30 minutes from the time you walk in to the time you walk out.
6. **Will you be doing pre-assessments with the kindergartners this year?** Yes, on Monday, May 15th. We will schedule your child's appointment time when you register.
7. **Will there be a kindergarten orientation prior to school starting next year?** Yes, there will a **KINDERGARTEN ORIENTATION** on **Tuesday, May 23th** from 6:00-6:30pm in the Multi-Purpose Room.
8. **What immunizations are required to register my child?**

4 - Polio (IPV/OPV) shots	5 - DTP Shots
3 - Hep B Shot	2 - MMR (Measles) shots
1 - Varicella (Chicken Pox) Shot	

ONLY EXCEPTIONS: 3 - Polio (IPV/OPV) shots if 3rd shot on/after 4th birthday
4 - DTP shots if 4th shot on/after 4th birthday
